## **Since July, Operation Sight has completed 26 surgeries!**

Through our leadership transition, Operation Sight has not skipped a beat. Thanks to our volunteer physicians and their teams, our program participants continue to receive impeccable care and sight-



saving surgeries.

## A New Partnership

This fall Operation Sight began partnering with **Harvest Free Medical Clinic** in North Charleston.

Harvest Free Medical Clinic is a free clinic providing care to South Carolina residents who are unemployed or do not have insurance. The clinic recently acquired an Optos retinal imaging machine through their relationship with MUSC and are now able to host free eye clinics one Saturday a month.

During the monthly eye clinic, MUSC physicians and residents provide screenings for patients with diabetic retinopathy, cataracts, glaucoma, and other issues. They are then able to refer patients to Operation Sight who may require additional care.

Since our partnership began at the end of September, Harvest Free Medical Clinic has referred 7 patients to Operation Sight!
